Dolton Parish Council comments on the Proposed Policy for Wind Energy Development are:

- 1. The timeframe for consultation is too short - the six week consultation period does not give Parish Councils, which generally meet once a month, time to fully understand and review the policy and then form a suitable collective response.*
- 2. The proposed policy, which runs to some 66 pages, is far too complex. At the very least it requires a simple, one-page synopsis explaining the main gist of the policy. Without this it is almost impossible for "enthusiastic amateurs" to make a rational decision.*
- 3. Dolton Parish council has a policy to consider all planning applications (including wind, solar developments etc.) on an individual case by case basis.*
