Minutes of the public meeting held Monday 5th February 2007

The chairman welcomed everybody to the meeting and stressed that this was now the time for members of the public to express their views about Deeds of Dedication for the playing fields of Dolton. The following members of the public spoke:-

- a) Mrs.J.Genge: explained the contents of the paper distributed to those present, including councillors, by DRAG.
- b) Ms.C.Beedles: is there any balanced argument against a deed of dedication with NPFA.
- c) Mr.R.Boyes: parish councils should be trusted now and in the future.
- d) Mr.Jenner-Parsons: equivalent facilities must be found.
- e) Mrs.C.Robinson: nothing personal against the Parish Council. It would be like making a will so that everything is sorted out.
- f) Mr.R.Dunn: there are more than 2 options. Set up Dolton Playing Fields Association and even try the Charity Commission.
- g) Mrs.D.Madge: why does a third party have to be involved. The Parish council could achieve the same thing.
- h) Mrs.P.Gander: why were the Parish council in favour of Dennis Cross and not so for the playing field.
- i) Mr.I.Williams: - can think of no alternative site for the football field
