

Dolton & Dowland Horticultural Society

I have been asked to provide a guide to people wishing to exhibit at the show.

- Exhibitors must live in the parishes of Dolton or Dowland. There is an exception for children under 16 staying with a resident of the two parishes on show day.
- With the exception of Floral Art, all horticultural exhibits must have been grown by or in the possession of the exhibitor for three months prior to the show.
- Entries are free and are made on an entry form available from Church Street Stores or the Secretary from about the third week in July.
- All handicraft exhibits should not have previously been exhibited at Dolton.
- Classes 77 – 84 (Knitwear, Needlework etc) should have been completed within the last 12 months
- Children's exhibits should be the unaided work of the child.
- All vases, trays etc. to be provided by the exhibitor.

To any new exhibitors it may seem quite daunting, but it isn't really. I hope you might be encouraged to enter this year, perhaps for the first time. It really is a great deal of fun.
