The amount still to be raised is approximately £2,500, which we now have on loan.


A box will be placed in the main hall on the day of the opening for the use of anyone wishing to make a donation.

May we take this opportunity to ask you to help us in any way you can to make the 29th April, 1967 an enjoyable day for everyone and a profitable day for the hall funds.


Thanking you for all your help you have given since 1964 which has been much appreciated.
