- 2) CARETAKER'S REPORT:
 - The two pictures donated by Mr Fitter have now been hung in the Hall
 - The line has been repainted around the slope to the door
 - The oil tank has been filled

- 3) MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: The minutes of the meeting held on 18th February have been circulated and were signed by Mrs Jury as a correct record.

- 4) MATTERS ARISING:
 - i) Mr Wainwright has given his hall keys to Mrs Jury, and these would now be given to Mrs McCulloch on behalf of the Cubs. The Secretary to send a keyholders form for signature.
 - ii) Mrs Jury had received a quote from Paul Middleton to convert the airing cupboard. It was agreed that the work should go ahead.

- ii) Mrs Stanford had obtained two quotes for cleaning the ovens.
- iii) Roger Dunn had been approached to ask if anything was being organised to mark the anniversary of the start of World War 1. The matter had also been discussed at the Parish Council meeting. It was decided that we should have a think about what could be done, and that we should discuss it at the next meeting.
- iv) Mrs Haynes thought that as most of the kitchen work has now been completed, we should thank the village for their support in our fundraising. The Secretary to put a notice up in the shop and on the noticeboard, and in the Diary. It was suggested that we should continue fundraising in order to purchase new crockery and cutlery.
- v) Mrs Chivers asked if we were going to do any fundraising for the flood relief effort in Somerset. It was decided that we would investigate and discuss at the next meeting.
